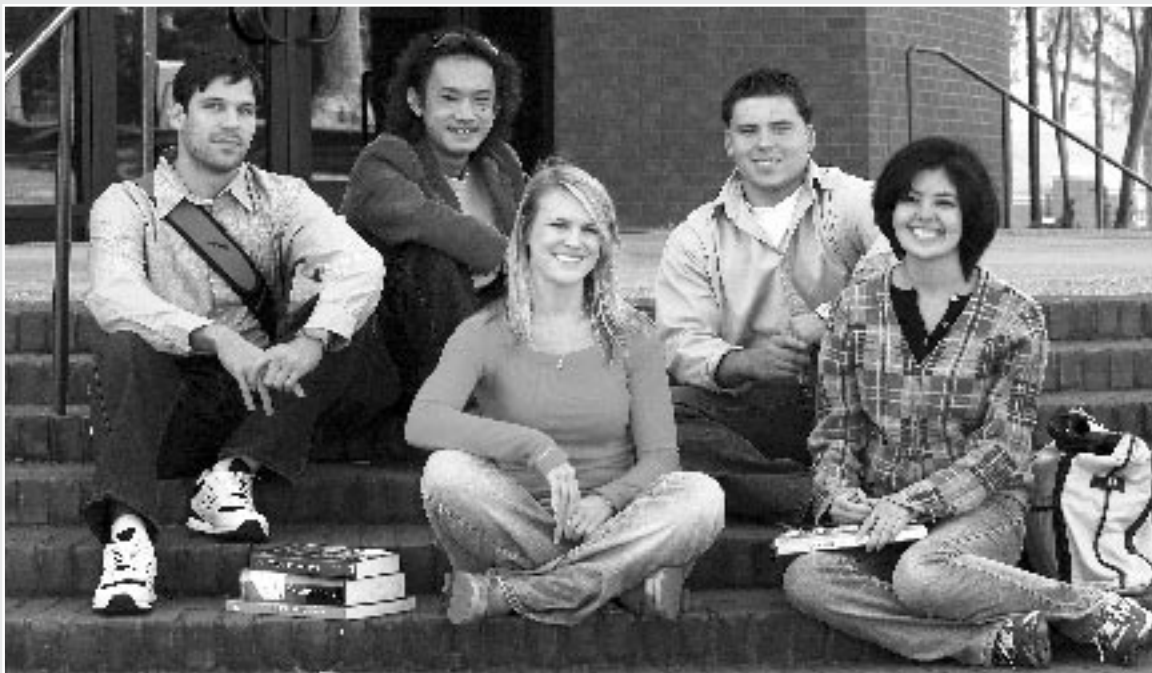

Admissions Checklist

Beginning Freshmen

Beginning freshmen are required to submit the following documents/information to the Office of Admissions before a final admissions decision can be made:

- Application for admission,
- \$20 application fee,
- Official high school transcript showing the *date of graduation* and *type of diploma* received,
- Immunization record(s), and
- Test scores – SAT, ACT or COMPASS placement exam may be required.

Transfer Students

Applicants are considered transfer students if they have enrolled in at least one other college or university prior to applying to Gordon College irrespective of the college credit received. Transfer students must submit the following documents/information before a final admissions decision can be made:

- Application for Admission,
- Final, Official Transcripts from all Colleges and Technical Schools/Colleges Attended,
- Immunization Record(s), and
- High School Transcript.*

* Although a high school transcript is required only for applicants with fewer than 30 transferable credit hours, all applicants are strongly encouraged to submit a high school transcript with their initial application. Submitting these documents with the initial application will reduce the potential for a delay in the acceptance/registration process.

Financial Aid Checklist

- Complete FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Remember to include Gordon's School Code 001575.
- Notify the Gordon College Financial Aid Office of all scholarships, financial aid assistants, tuition waivers and other aid you expect to receive for the year.
- Receive Student Aid Report (SAR) from the federal processor. Is the SAR complete and correct?
- Check your financial aid application status by logging into your Gordon BannerWeb account.
- Print a verification worksheet when instructed by the Financial Aid Office
- Check BannerWeb to see if you have an award notice.
- If you wish to apply for a loan, you must submit a Gordon College student loan request form.
- If you wish to apply for a Parent Plus loan, you must submit a Gordon College federal plus loan request.
- If you are given a loan, you must electronically sign your master promissory note.
- If you are awarded a plus loan, you must complete the Plus Loan promissory note.

Apply Early. FAFSAs should be completed as soon as 2009 tax forms are complete. For more information, visit <http://www.gdn.edu/FinancialAid/finaidinfo.asp>.

Housing Checklist

To apply for on-campus housing at Gordon, please complete the requirements below. Housing is limited so students are encouraged to apply early. Please note: Students will not be assigned a room until they are accepted for admission to Gordon College.

- Fill out the Residence Hall Contract available online at <http://www.gdn.edu/housing/application.asp>.
- In addition to the Residence Hall Contract, download and complete the Gordon Commons and Gordon Village Lease Agreement, if apartment style housing is desired.
- Mail/send the signed Lease Agreement to the Business Office, Gordon College, 419 College Drive, Barnesville, GA 30204.
- Mail/send your \$300 processing fee to the Gordon College Business Office.
- Check Gordon email for room assignment information.

Driving Directions

I-75 South from Atlanta

Take Exit 201 and turn right onto GA 36 West. Travel approximately 14 miles, and bear right at the fork in the road (continuing on GA-36 West). Turn left at the stop sign onto US 41/7. Continue four miles, and turn left at the Marathon Gas Station onto College Drive and look for visitor parking on the left behind the Welcome Center.

I-75 North from Macon

Take Exit I-75 onto Harold G. Clark Pkwy (Hwy 18), turn left off ramp. Just over railroad tracks road dead ends. Turn right onto Hwy 18/41 which takes you to Barnesville. Turn left at the McDonald's on College Drive. Drive past campus and look for visitor parking on the right.
